"Chuck" Brawner Councilmember Ward A; and, Durran C. Dowdle, Councilmember Ward B

Motion was made by Councilmember Jones, seconded by Councilmember Mendez, approving as printed and read (*caption*) an Ordinance (No. 2749) Canvassing and Declaring the Results of the Regular Officers' Election held on the 7th Day of May, 2016, for the Purpose of Electing a Councilmember At-Large, One Councilmember from Ward B, and Declaring Steve Pierson Councilmember At-Large, Charles A. "Chuck" Brawner Councilmember Ward A; and, Durran C. Dowdle, Councilmember Ward B. All voted Aye, and the motion carried.

Issue Certificates of Election and Administer Oaths of Office to Councilmember At-Large Pierson and Councilmembers Brawner and Dowdle (May 7, 2016, Regular City Officers' Election declared elected by Ordinance No. 2749 on 05-16-2016)
