Current Conditions



Proposed Improvements (1 of 4)

- ▶ Construction will begin on the east end of the project on the West side of Cane Island Branch of Buffalo Bayou
- ▶ This section will consist of new 80-inch and 84-inch storm sewer that will be installed under the asphalt paving

Proposed Improvements (2 of 4)

- ▶ The new storm sewer will serve the new concrete paving and will help with the flooding issues that plagued West Katy during Hurricane Harvey
- ▶ The additional runoff from the new storm sewer will be offset by the City expanding the Regional Detention Pond on Pitts Road with two additional phases of expansion

Proposed Improvements (3 of 4)

- ▶ The new three lanes of concrete pavement will begin at Bartlett Road and extend west to the former Carolina Street railroad crossing
- ▶ The pavement will have one East bound lane, one West bound lane and a protected turn lane

Proposed Improvements (4 of 4)

- ▶ New sidewalks will be provided from the East side of Cane Island Parkway to Bartlett Street
- ▶ Construction started Monday 11/5/2018 and will last approximately 12 months
